The original reliefs for these cast panels were made by members of The Full Gospel Church, Brandon as part of the Via Beata project, which aims to set up a complete trail of artworks from Lowestoft in the East to St. David's in the West. The trail is using existing footpaths and rights-of-way to enable walkers of all ages to pilgrimage across the U.K. and meditate upon the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The words on these panels are from a conversation which Jesus had with a woman by a well in Samaria (see John 4 v 14), and from words spoken to the crowds in Jerusalem (see John 7 v 38). To all who recognise their need, Jesus can both satisfy, and fill to overflowing with his love and grace.



The **Via Beata** was launched in the Summer of 2009.

It is on course to become a complete trail of Christian artworks stretching across the UK from East to West at its widest point.

Artworks which communicate the Christian Gospel are being commissioned and set up in situations where people can stop and meditate upon them.
