

Little Stukeley to Little Gidding - 9 miles

Overview

Gentle walk through mostly open countryside following well signed footpaths, and bridleways. Little road work mostly through the villages. Towards the end of the walk, the countryside starts to become undulating.

Points of Interest

St John's church at Little Gidding.

T.S Eliot's Four Quartets, one of which named after Little Gidding.

Route

From closed church car park in Little Stukeley, turn right onto main road. Opposite Church Way, turn left. At junction turn left onto Low Road. Cross A14 (M) by road bridge.

Turn right onto byway after bridge. Firstly parallel to A14 (M), then follow bridleway northwest. Through metal gate onto concrete path, through metal gate then under the A1(M) into Alconbury.

Walk through village towards church. Footpath on right of churchyard. Turn left (Alconbury Brook) following path down the hill. Turn left between houses and straight across Hamerton Road into Alconbury Weston

Walk through village, then turn right onto footpath just between cottage and "Stump Hill". Through metal kissing gate to further gate in corner of field. Turn right along field margin. Cross field over style. Then cross field diagonally and through metal gate at end of path.

Turn right, join track. At road, turn right with Manor Farm on left. Turn left onto bridleway, then onto bridleway "Bullock Road".

At junction with road, turn right, then left before Hill Top Farm back onto Bullock Road. Follow track straight ahead, with Aversley Wood on right.

After Cold Harbour Farm on left hand side, turn left towards Bottom Farm.

At road, turn right, then left, following signs to Little Gidding.
