## Quidenham to Roudham Heath - 7 miles

## Overview

An easy walk, mostly on minor roads until the path goes under the A11 and then onto Roudham Heath. Some of the walk follows Hereward Way.

## Route

From the cross at Quidenham Monastery, walk to the road, turn left. Follow the road to the T junction and turn left. Pass the church on the left then take the next right onto the Quidenham Road - pass "Woodlands" on the left and continue into East Harling. At the end of White Hart Street turn right onto the B1111. Pass the church on the right, then take next left towards Bridgham soon passing Flint Farm on the right. Continue on to the outskirts of Bridgham.

Opposite Manor Farm, turn right down the byway (Roudham Stud) towards Roudham. At junction with Roudham Road, turn left onto road and Hereward Way through the village, with the remains of St Andrews church on the left.

Just after the site of the Medieval Village of Roudham, take the right fork and turn immediately right again following the Hereward Way "Restricted byway" signs, and past Shepherd's Barn. Cross over railway line and then under the A11 road bridge. Continue to follow the path of the Hereward Way to the Fire Tower/Mobile phone mast. Turn left and continue forwards down the forest track for about 450 yards to the Way Station on the right in Roudham Woods.
